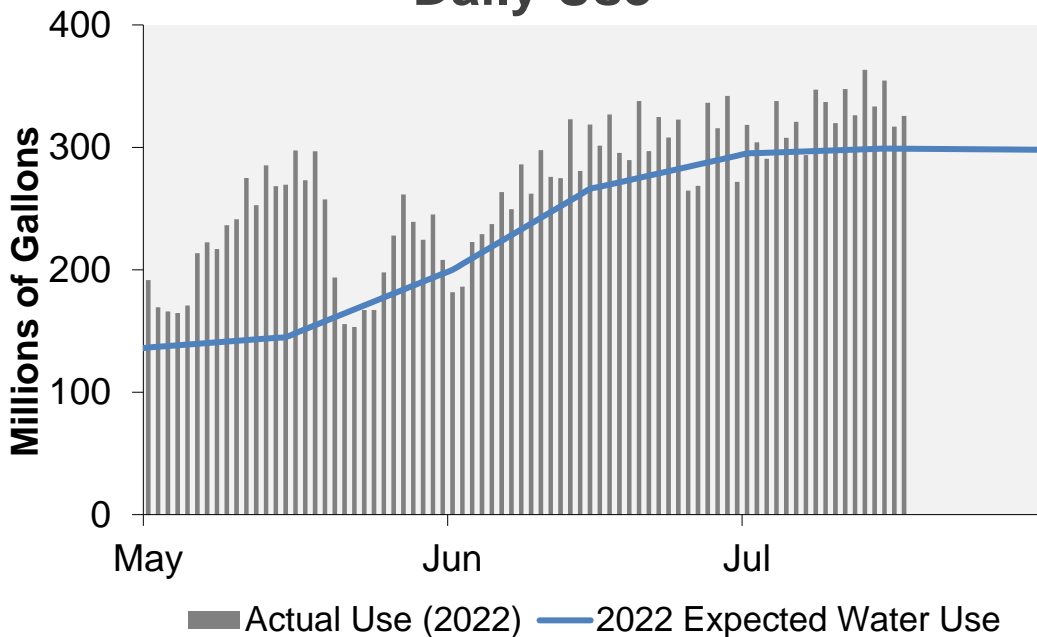

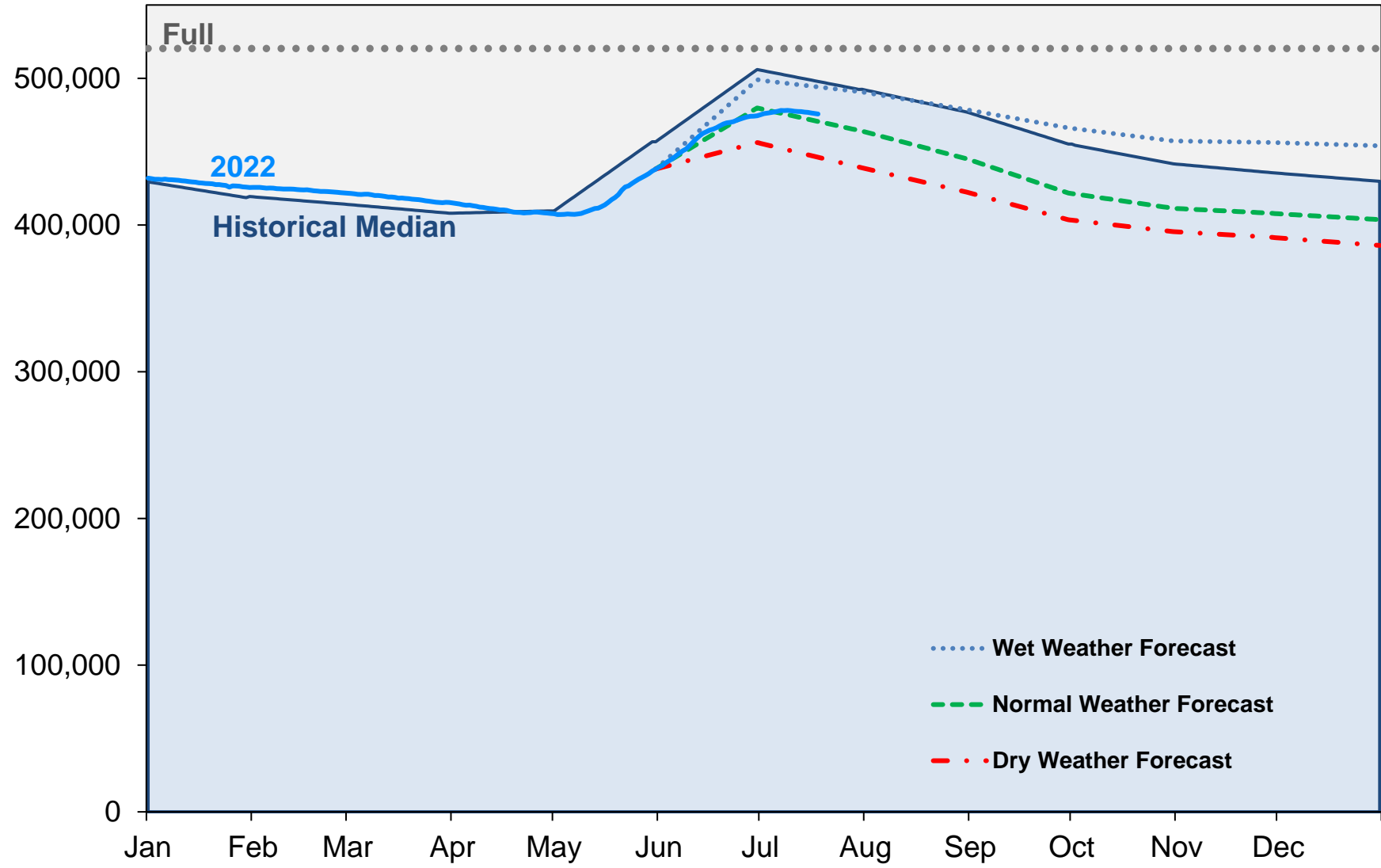

Acre-Feet

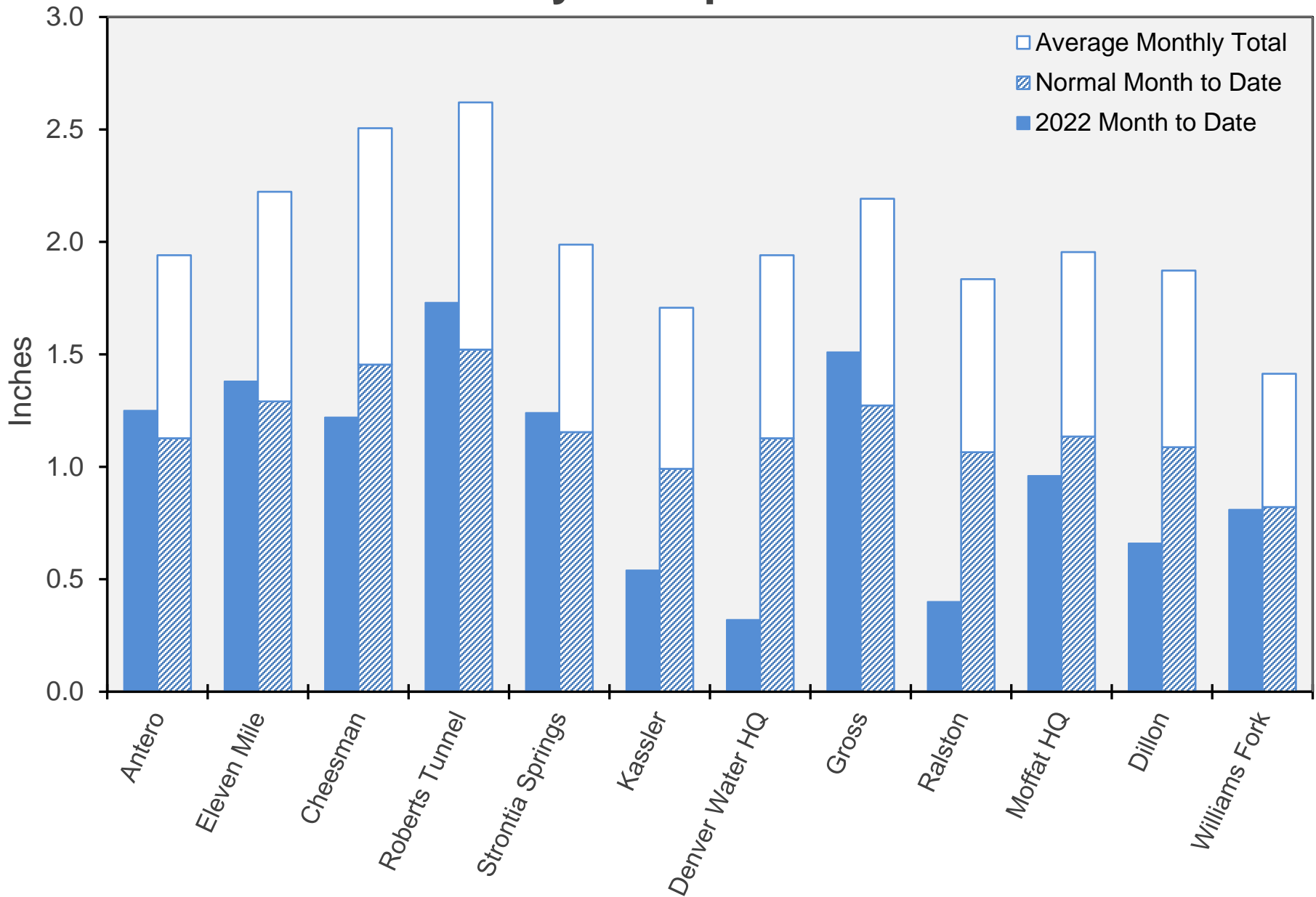

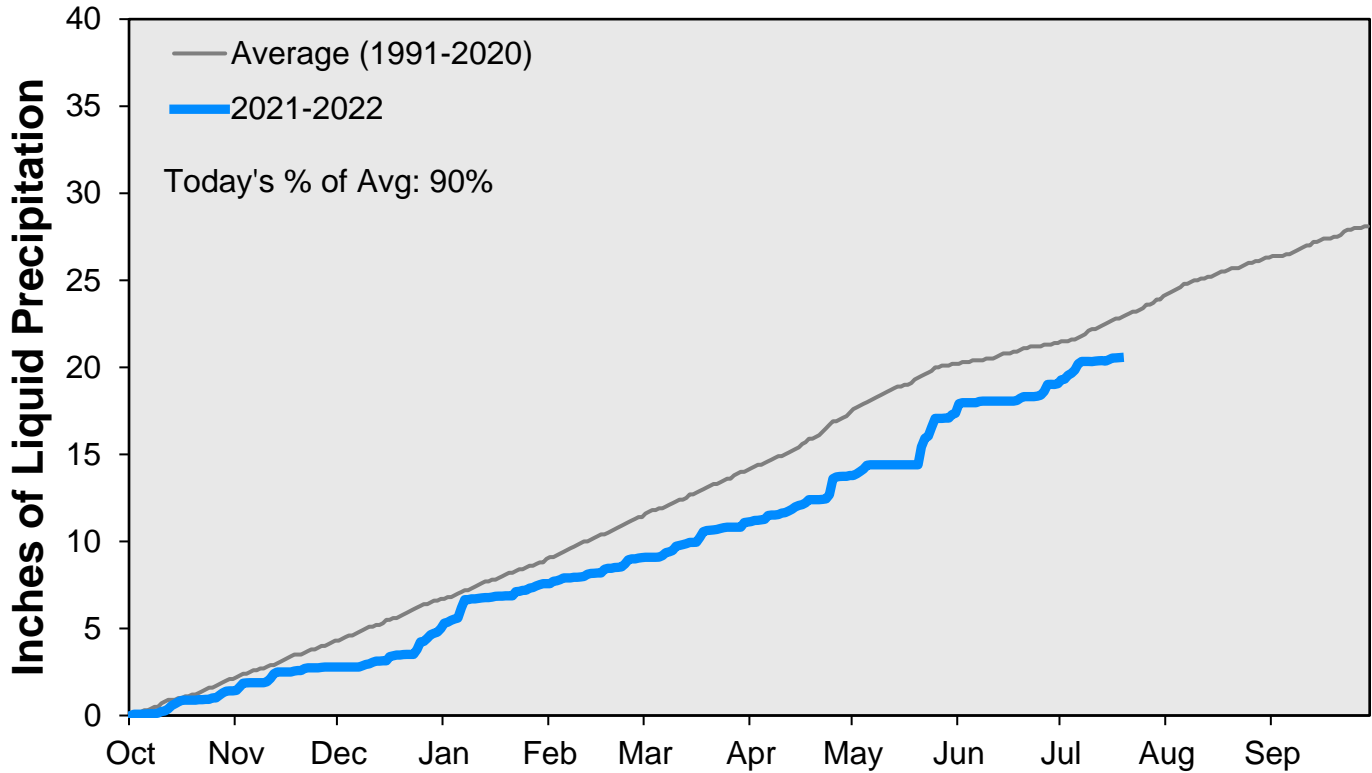
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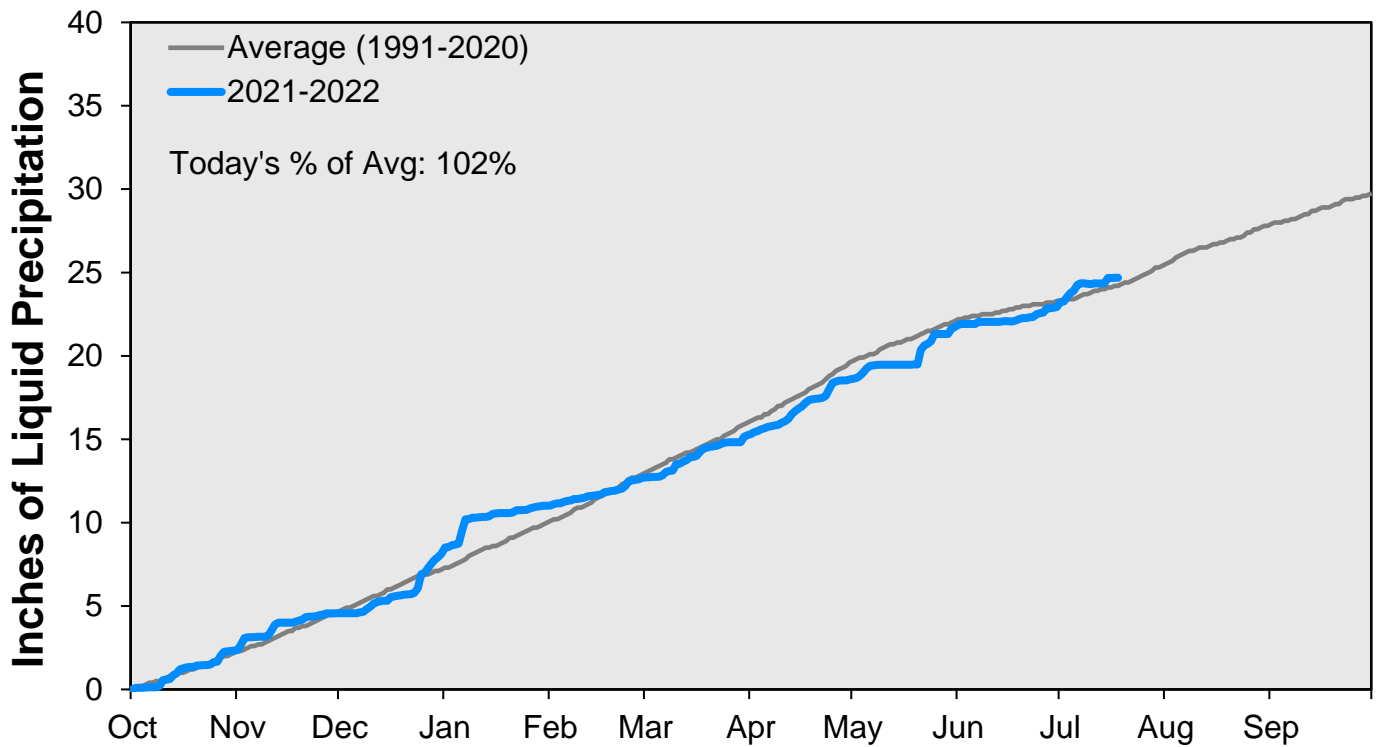
July Precipitation



CUMULATIVE PRECIPITATION: SOUTH PLATTE RIVER WATERSHED

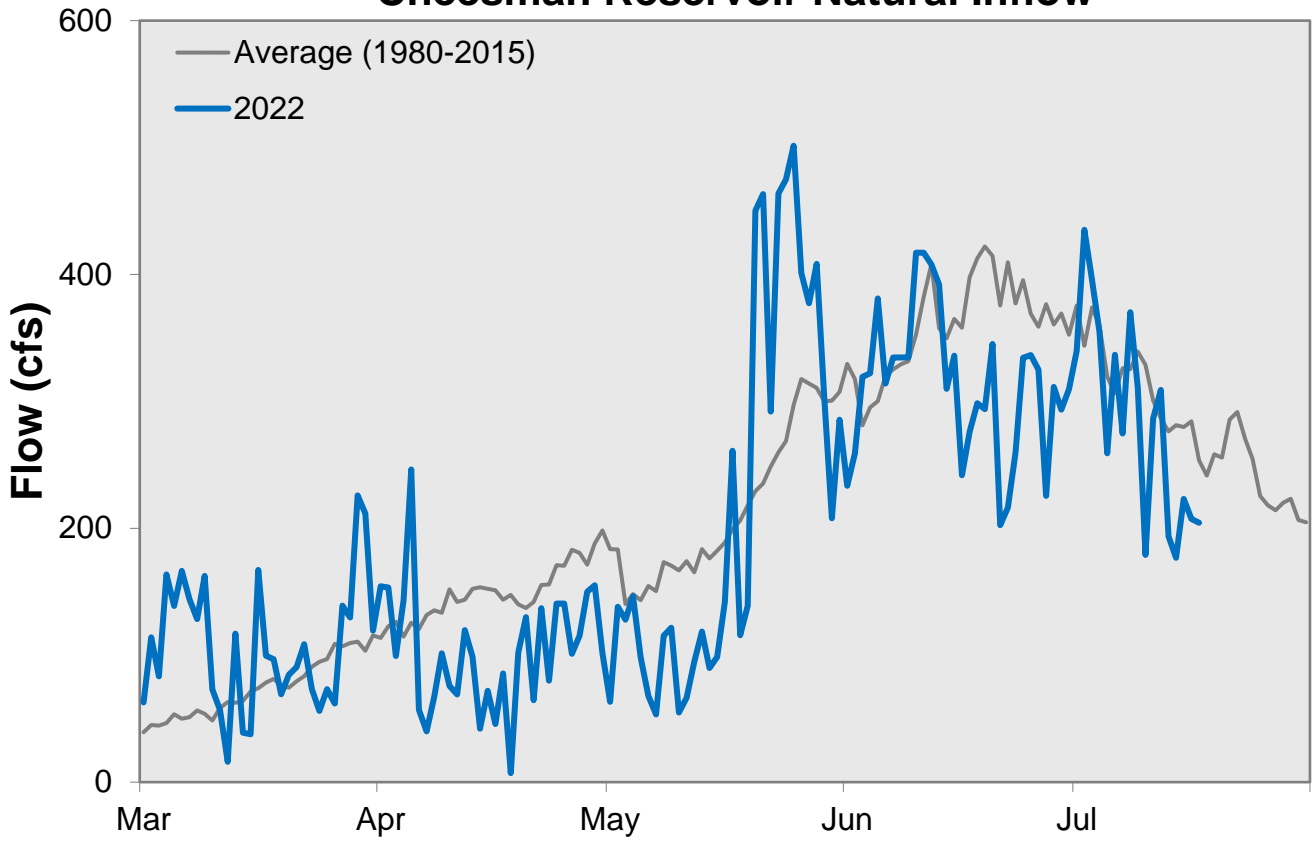


CUMULATIVE PRECIPITATION: COLORADO RIVER WATERSHED

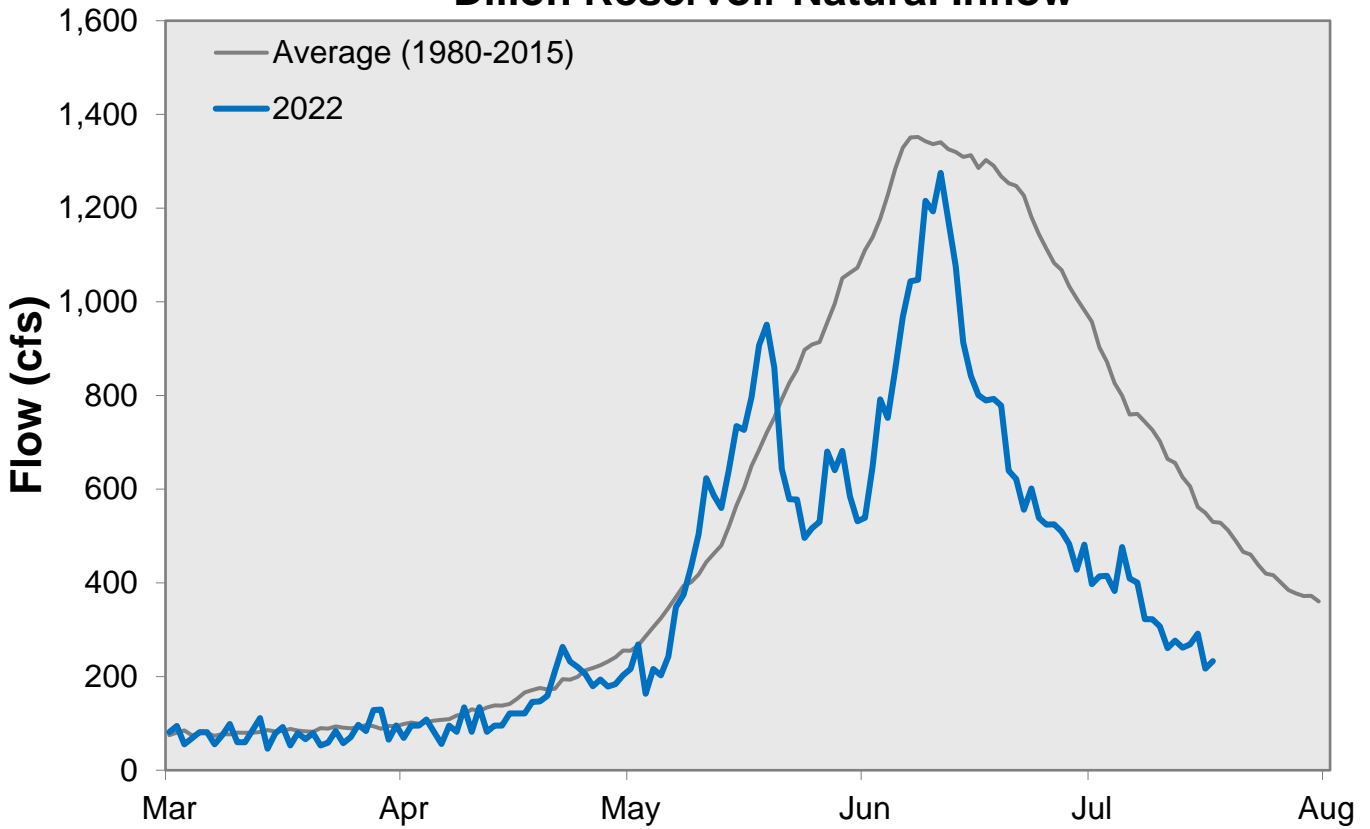

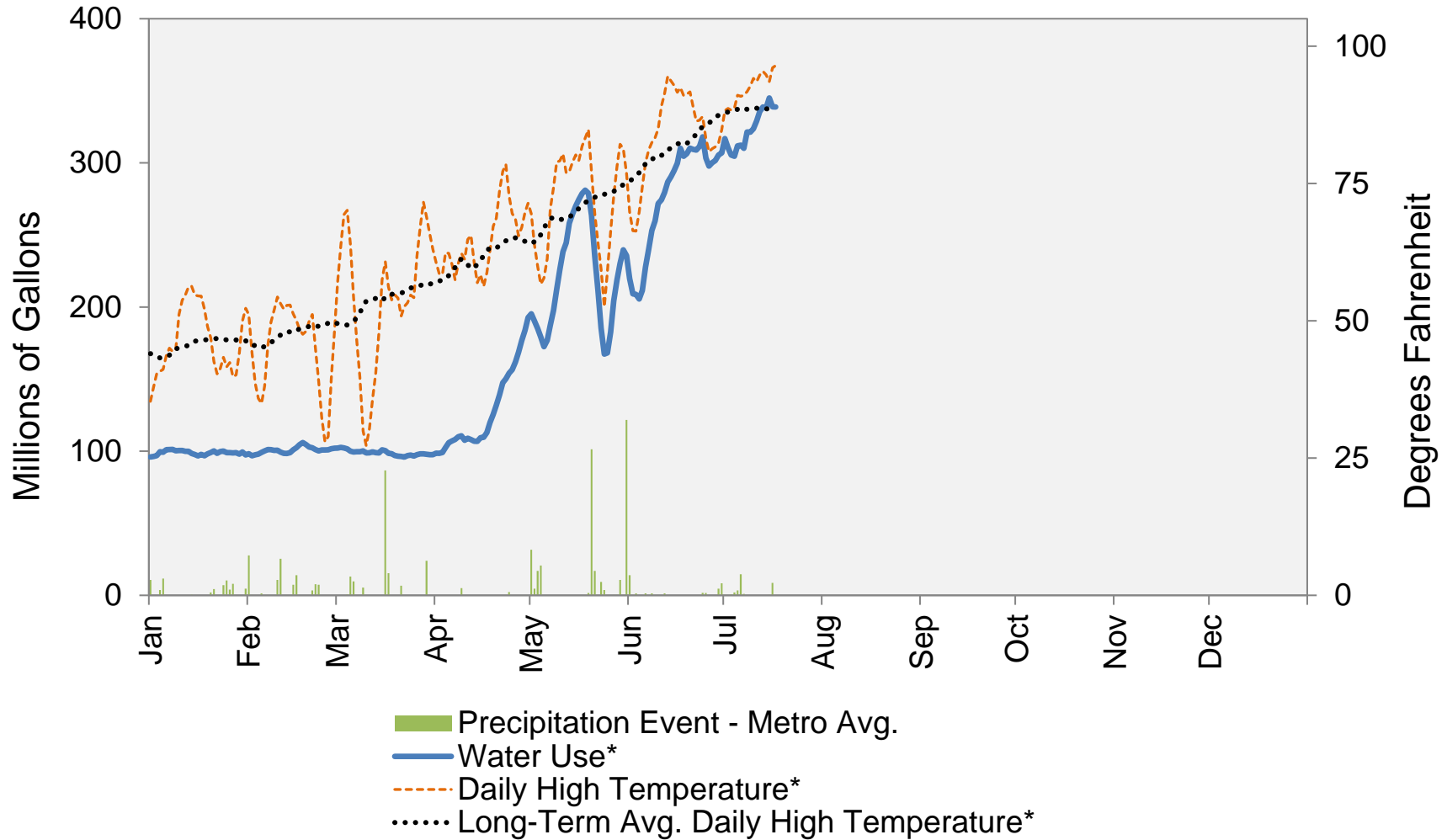
Cheesman Reservoir Natural Inflow

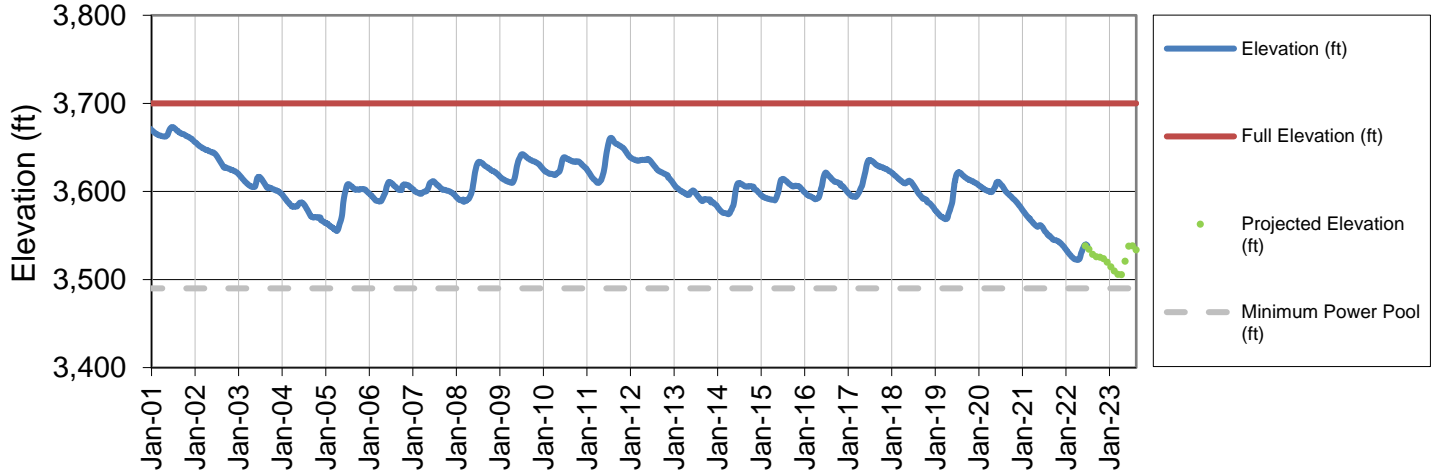

"MG" denotes million gallons. 2) Expected Daily Use is based on historical use with normal weather conditions. 3) The predicted end-of-month supply reservoir contents figures assume normal weather after July 5th, 2022. 4) The differences between predicted and actual end-of-month supply reservoir contents are the result of normal estimation error of daily use, supply, evaporation, carriage losses and raw water deliveries. 5) Predicted supply reservoir contents last updated on July 5th, 2022. 6) Daily water figures are subject to change.
